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Name: Duncan Peter Anderson, 1894-1952

Duncan Peter Anderson Collection.- 1894-1952.- 5 cm of textual records and 2 ferrotypes.

Biographical Sketch: Dr. Duncan Peter Anderson, born at Chaudiere Basin, Quebec, graduated from McGill University with a B.A. in 1890 and a M.D. in 1897. After graduation he lectured at McGill and at one time was assistant pathologist at the Montreal General Hospital. With Dr. Albert Vipond he founded the Montreal Children's Hospital. Dr. Anderson was Assistant-Demonstrator in Pathology, 1898-1901 and Demonstrator in 1904. (Canadian Medical Association Journal v. 68, pg. 184, 1953)

Custodial History: Gift of Mrs. Colin K. Anderson, daughter-in-law of Dr. Duncan Anderson, Westmount, Quebec, 8 November 1976. Old accession number 553.

Scope and Content: Collection includes a scrapbook and a file of memorabilia of Dr. Anderson and his family, 1894-1952. It contains letters, menus, programmes, certificates, a manuscript of a poem, a contract to purchase, ferrotypes, and many newspaper clippings.

Source of supplied title proper: Based on the documents in the collection.

Language: The documents are mainly in English and some are in French.

Finding Aids: Inventory list available.

General Note: Newspaper clippings to restore. Conservation and description of the collection to be done.
